# 2025 - 500 600 Tournaments - Rules

### 1. ELIGIBILITY

- a. The tournament is open to all female USBC certified bowlers who are members of the Milwaukee Women's 500 600 Bowling Club.
- b. Entrants may compete only once in each tournament.
- c. This tournament is certified by the USBC, and all USBC tournament rules will apply

## 2. ENTERING AVERAGE

i.

- a. Leagues designated as Sport/Challenge will be adjusted using the USBC average adjustment scale, if it is the only average available (USBC Rule 201c)
- b. Bowlers must report any rerated/adjusted average from any other tournament or association
- c. Averages used for tournament eligibility apply in this order
  - Highest USBC league average
    - 1. 2024-2025 winter season for 21 or more games
    - 2. 2024-2025 summer season for 21 or more games
  - ii. If no average, bowler will use a 220 average
  - iii. If the current average (21 games or more) is 15 or more pins higher than the entering average, the current average must be used at the time of bowling the 1st event
- d. It shall be the bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of a series, shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average (USBC Rule 319a-3)

### 3. FORMAT

- a. Bowlers will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes.
- b. Handicap will be 100% of 220

#### 4. CASH PRIZE LIST

- a. All prize money will be returned 100%
- b. A cash prize list will be based on at least 1 in 5 ratio

### 5. ENTRY FEES

- a. Entries must be accompanied by the full amount of fees
- b. Fees can be made via check, or cash
- c. Entry fees consist of:
  - i. Prize Fee \$16.00
  - ii. Bowling Fee \$9.00
  - iii. Expense Fee \$10.00

### 6. STANDARD TOURNAMENT ITEMS

- a. Entries close September 21, 2025.
- b. Maximum number of bowlers per lane is 3.
- c. Maximum individual handicap score may not exceed 300
- d. Maximum individual handicap series may not exceed 900.
