

Tournament Rules

- 1. Entry is open to all USBC certified bowlers who are members of the Milwaukee Women's 500 600 Bowling Club.
- 2. Entrants may compete only once in each tournament. The events will consist of 3 games on a scheduled pair of lanes.
- 3. Handicap will be 100% of 220. Handicaps will be based on highest certified USBC league average 2022-2023 (18 games or more). If no 2022-2023 certified USBC winter league average, then highest certified USBC summer league average 2022-2023(18 games or more). Bowlers with none of the above will use highest 2021-2022 USBC certified average.
- 4. No money will be refunded after entries are recorded and scheduled.
- 5. All prize money will be returned 100% at a ratio of one (1) prize for each five (5) entries.
- 6. Duplicate awards will be given in the event of ties. If there is a tie, prize money will be divided equally.
- 7. Any errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament manager within 48 hours. Any protest regarding eligibility or playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the tournament manager before the tournament prize lists are made.
- 8. Any player arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. All frames missed will be a zero.
- 9. USBC Rule 319a-1, 319a-2, 319d, and 319e do not apply.
- 10. Failure to use correct average USBC Rule 319a-3 will apply. It shall be each entrant's responsibility to verify the accuracy of her average. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than correct average. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than correct average. If you bowl in more than one association, it is the highest of all associations.
